ANTI-HIV-1 p24

PRODUCT CHARACTERISTICS

This murine monoclonal antibody reacts with Human Immunodeficiency Virus Type 1 (HIV-1) p24 protein. The antibody is of the IgG₁ subclass and has been purified from serum-free culture supernatant by ammonium sulfate precipitation. The antibody is supplied as purified immunoglobulin in phosphate-buffered saline. MONOBODIES Anti-HIV-1 p24 (clone 38/8.7.47) exhibits reactivity with HIV-1 infected cultures using indirect immunofluorescence. It also exhibits reactivity with viral lysates examined using Western blotting. In addition, the antibody immunoprecipitates p24 protein from radiolabeled infected cell extracts.

RECOMMENDED USAGE

Antibody dilutions should be prepared using buffers containing suitable protein in order to stabilize antibody activity. The antibody is used to detect HIV-1 core protein in virus infected cells as well as in viral or infected cell ysates. Studies on core antigen synthesis and metabolism can be performed using Western blotting or radioimmunoprecipitation analysis.

STORAGE

Aliquot and store at -20°C.
